AQPA MULTI BREED ONLINE SHOW

Conditions of Entry

1. The AQPA reserves the right to add, delete, combine or otherwise alter any part of the program without notice.
2. All rings will be judged by a qualified and/or accredited judge using appropriate judging method/s. The judges decision is final.
3. There are no refunds or protests.
4. A horses age is calculated from 1st August.
5. Horse or pony must be registered with the applicable breed society (for breed classes) and owned by the person entering. Proof of registration is not required but may be requested or checked with the applicable breed society. Registration details must be included on the entry form.
6. Pending registrations will be accepted unless otherwise specified.
7. Entrants found to provide false or misleading information will be disqualified.
8. Entrants for all classes must be residents of Australia or New Zealand.
9. Horse and owner names will not be displayed until judging is completed.
10. ONE HORSE PER ENTRY FORM. Please follow instructions on entry form very carefully. Ensure all photographs are named with the class number and horse or pony's full name.
11. All entries must be received and paid for by the closing date or they will not be eligible for class/es. All winners will be posted on our website and all ribbons, sashes and prizes will be sent by ordinary mail.
12. Handler or Rider may be presented in western or English attire
13. Led classes may be presented in a halter or bridle of western or English type
14. Ridden classes may be presented in western or English or as specified for the class.

Photos, DVD or other footage

1. Photos submitted in digital format must be minimum 300 DPI and maximum 600 DPI.
2. Photos submitted in hard copy must be minimum 6 x 4 maximum 5 x 9. They must be clear and not printed on paper. If reprinted the must be on photo quality paper.
3. DVD, video or other "movie" footage must be submitted as required for each class.
4. Photos, DVD's or videos will not be returned unless a stamped, self addressed envelope is provided.
5. Professional photos or footage may be submitted providing they are accompanied by written permission from the photographer. Name of photographer must be submitted with any photo/s or otherwise at time of entry.
6. **Photos must not be modified or enhanced in any way.**
7. No photos showing horses wearing ribbons or with advertising or with signs saying name, breeding or winner of an event will be accepted.
8. Photos must be have been taken within the last 12 months with the exception of costume classes. Photos of foals must be no more than 12 months old.
9. The same photo may be submitted for multiple classes or a separate photo for each class entered. You must nominate, on your entry form which photo is submitted for each class.
10. For breed or led classes photo must be taken standing side-on (showing the horse as you would present it if you were in a real show ring) must be provided for each horse unless otherwise specified. Judging will be on conformation.
11. For performance classes photo may be taken from any angle but it must be obvious what the horse is doing or represents. Horse and rider must be visible. Judging will be as applicable.
15. For novelty classes photo may be taken from any angle but it must be obvious what the horse is doing or represents. Judging will be as applicable.
16. AQPA may use photos or images at their discretion without the permission of the owner. Unless the owner specifically stipulates that the photos are not to be used.
